Joining Dr. Jha at the clinic are the practice's Board-certified nurse practitioners Ann Hinson, FNP-C, and Aaron Houser, FNP-C.

"Our goal at Low Country Cancer Care is to provide compassionate and comprehensive cancer care that is tailored to the individual needs of each of our patients, and this remains true at our Alma clinic," said Dr. Jha. "We will work closely with each patient to develop a personalized treatment plan that is right for them and then provide the support they need throughout their cancer journey.
